



## Mountain Park COVID-19 Guidelines

Overall, we commit to:

- Follow the latest policies, procedures, and practices to operate in compliance with Orders, physical distancing, capacities, or other requirements as established by state and local authorities.
- Follow the "Cleaning and Disinfecting Your Facility", "Fact Sheet/Prevention/Response" to safeguard employees and guests from COVID-19.
- In addition to National and Local Government restrictions, follow precautions of our manufacturers.
- Provide signage visible to guests and employees addressing recommendations to "Stop the Spread".
- Offer complete transparency and provide expectations for all employees and guests.

Employee Safety and Protocols:

- Educate on symptoms of COVID-19 and related illness policies.
- Each staff member completing a COVID-19 Employee Health-Screening Form for every workday.
- Proper handwashing and respiratory etiquette per CDC standards.
- Employees being supplied and wearing proper Personal Protective Equipment as needed.
- Physical distancing of staff at the worksite IE: cashier stations.
- Enhanced training on Personal Protective Equipment and Safety Data Sheets to ensure employees can safely use provided supplies in compliance with the CDC and difference between cleaning and sanitizing.
- Physical distancing and appropriate cleanliness being maintained in employee break areas.
- Workspace disinfection prior to employee/shift changes IE: workstations and equipment.
- Routine disinfection of Equipment utilized for activities after use.
- Regular use of electrostatic disinfecting-cleaning machine.

Public Spaces:

- Pens, credit card machines, and cashier counter spaces being regularly disinfected.
- Increase hand sanitizing station availability.
- Disinfection of the Mountain Park Building and highly touched surface areas.
- Frequently sanitize restrooms and guest entrances using electrostatic disinfecting machines.
- Regular use of electrostatic disinfecting-cleaning machine.
- Plexiglass sneeze guards at staff / guest counters.
- Touch free trash cans within the Mountain Park.
- Increase the number of points of sales where tickets are redeemed.
- Advanced reserved ticket sales by calling Central Reservations at 800-642-9477 and release form availability for prearrival completion.
- Appropriate spacing within the Mountain Park Building of space for onsite completion of release forms for small groupings with a minimum of 6' distancing.
- Appropriate physical distancing throughout the resort, including any waiting areas and participation in activities.
- Mountain Park indoor seating follows Governor and Local Orders on capacity restrictions using physical distancing requirements.
- Maintain CDC recommendations for physical distancing of outdoor seating locations.
- Face coverings are always to be worn indoors by everyone age 5 or older.
- Face coverings are to be worn outside if 6' physical distancing is not possible.
- Face coverings are required for snow tubing while in the lift waiting area, loading the lift, riding the lift, unloading the lift, on the tubing hill, and riding the tube by everyone over the age of 5.
- Face coverings are required for the Mountain Coaster while in the waiting areas, loading the cart, riding the cart, and unloading the cart by everyone age 5 or older.
- Face coverings include surgical masks, cloth masks, scarfs, bandanas, neck gaiter, and full-face shields. Face coverings must cover the mouth and nose.
